- Confer with supervisory personnel, owners, contractors, or design professionals to discuss and resolve matters, such as work procedures, complaints, or construction problems
- Plan, organize, or direct activities concerned with the construction or maintenance of structures, facilities, or systems
- Study job specifications to determine appropriate construction methods
- Inspect or review projects to monitor compliance with building and safety codes or other regulations
- Implement training programs on environmentally responsible building topics to update employee skills and knowledge

Requirements

- 3 years of experience as an assistant superintendent in construction or related work and in-depth knowledge of occupational trades and apprenticeships
- Experience with MS Excel, MS Word, Bluebeam, and Procore
- Experience reading plans, installation instructions and other construction documents
- Must be OSHA 10 certified for the Construction Industry (OSHA 30 is preferred)
- Must have a valid Driver's License
- Travel may be required

- Involves work at a construction site where duties will be performed both indoors and outdoors
- The employee is regularly required to sit, stand and walk; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl
- The employee must occasionally lift and move up to 50 pounds
