Maintenance Technician-Electrician

Title: Maintenance Technician-Electrician

Reports to: Maintenance Manager or Production Manager

Classification: Non-Exempt

Summary:

The Maintenance Technician-Electrician performs the preventive and reactive maintenance duties required for the manufacturing operations of the plant. Priorities include execution of PM schedules, repair of any equipment that is needed to maintain maximum production rates. This position generally requires the flexibility to work 40+ hours per week, weekends as required and also fulfill on-call duties for repairs.

Primary Job Responsibilities:

The responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to:

- Practice proper PPE compliance and maintain a safe working record and environment
- Immediately communicate unsafe conditions, acts or injuries to PIM.
- Practice proper forklift operation
- Maintain facility housekeeping
- Maintain and build job skills through company training programs
- Troubleshoot and repair equipment that is not operating properly
- Ensure that all equipment is kept in a proper and safe working condition
- Direct and ensure that all scheduled Preventive Maintenance duties are completed
- Communicate with all plant personnel
- Communicate with PLP support services
- Assist with PLP support service team projects
- Understand and practice PLP CORE VALUES

Job Skills:

This position should possess the following skills/knowledge:

- Advanced industrial mechanical, electrical, plumbing, hydraulic and pneumatic skills including troubleshooting
- Understanding of PLP manufacturing process including troubleshooting
- Strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work with and communicate to other plant personnel
- Basic computer skills
- Understand purpose and proper use of small hand and power tools
- Strong time management and task prioritization skills
- Self-motivation
- Ability to troubleshoot simple and complex system.

Educational Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Industrial Electrician License or Certification
- Continuing Education certifications, preferred

Preferred Experience:

- 3-5 years experience as industrial electrician or similar training and experience
- Previous maintenance experience in a manufacturing industry
- Plastic pipe extrusion and / or cnc machine.
