

In-Home Caregiver

Position Summary

The In-Home Caregiver provides compassionate, person-centered support to clients in their homes, following an established plan of care. This role ensures the safety, comfort, and well-being of each client while promoting independence and dignity.

Qualifications

- Minimum **18 years of age**
- Ability to **lift, push, and pull up to 50 lbs**
- Ability to **read, write, and communicate effectively in English**
- No formal certification or registration required for basic caregiver duties

Responsibilities

1. Provide direct patient care according to the **service plan of care** developed by the Agency Program Supervisor, Registered Nurse, or managed care program.
2. Perform care tasks only within the scope of one's **training, competency**.
3. Maintain a **safe, clean, and comfortable environment** through routine housekeeping duties.
4. Prepare **routine and therapeutic meals** based on client needs.
5. Assist clients with **Activities of Daily Living (ADLs)**, including bathing, grooming, dressing, toileting, and mobility.
6. Offer **basic emotional and psychological support** to clients and their families.
7. Assist with **transportation** to medical appointments, grocery shopping, and other essential outings.
8. Document all care provided and submit records through the **agency's app** after each visit.
9. Immediately report any **changes in the client's condition** to the Program Supervisor.
10. Respond appropriately to **emergencies** without direct supervision.
11. Participate in required **in-service training** and continuing education.
12. Perform **Homemaker/Companion** duties as assigned.
