PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS/ENVIRONMENTAL SETTING (Indoors/Outdoors):

Move safely, quickly, and perform duties with repetitious movement. Standing/walking, crouching, kneeling/crawling, stooping/twisting, bending at the waist, climbing, balancing, leg/foot use, reaching/handling, grasping, and sitting. Employee must be able to push, pull, lift, or carry up to 70 lbs. This job requires interaction with others, deadlines, shift work, and highly repetitive work. Employee will be exposed to elements and must follow certain safety requirements. Must be able to tolerate all weather elements, loud conditions, vibrations, and airborne particles (sawdust). **Hard hats and safety glasses must be worn.**
